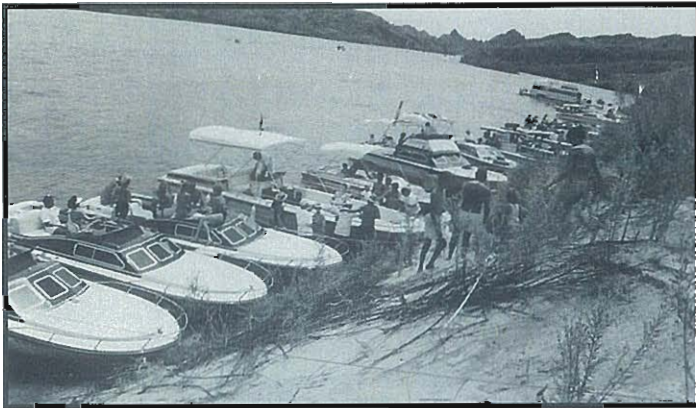

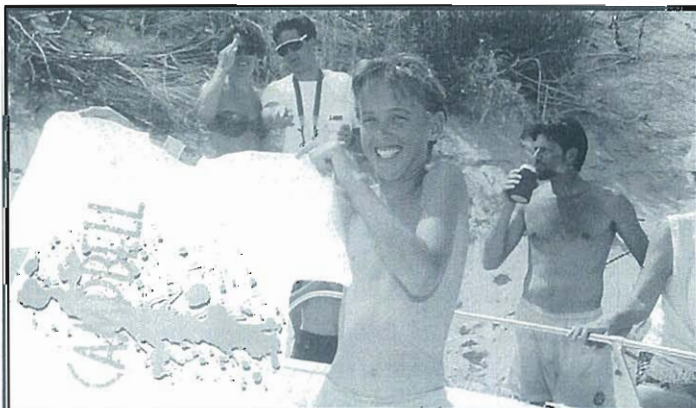

Friday, September 11, 1992

Registration at Campbell Boat Service Co., 850 London Bridge Road from 9 am to 6 pm.

Cocktail party, dinner, dancing and continued registration at the factory 6:00 to 9:00 pm.

Saturday, September 12, 1992

Free beer on the Nautical Beach from 9 am to 5 pm.

Timed ski races off Nautical Inn from 9 to 11 am. Two runs, best time, any skier.

Poker run from 10:30 to 1:00 pm. Sign up on beach, \$15 per poker hand and \$5 per "21" hand.

Timed slalom race 1 pm to 5 pm. Best time of two runs.

Boat parade from the south end of the channel to under the London Bridge from 6 to 7 pm.

Fred Sez

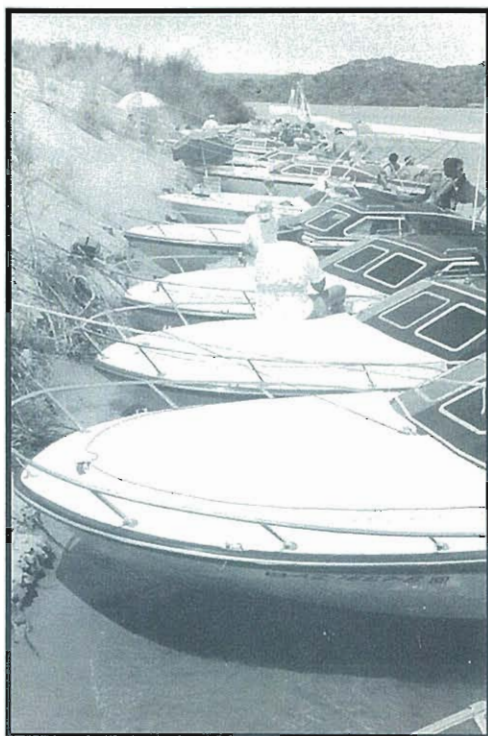
Again we would like to suggest the installation of a "kill switch" if you intend to take part in the competitive events at the Regatta. This shuts off the boat's engine in the event that the driver is thrown away from the wheel. If this should happen on the back straightaway of the slalom, for example, an unpiloted boat could carry on into the line-up of boats waiting their turn to run.

The switch retails for \$29.95 and requires an hour's labor to install, but as a service we will put one in your boat for a total of \$45. Just give us a call.

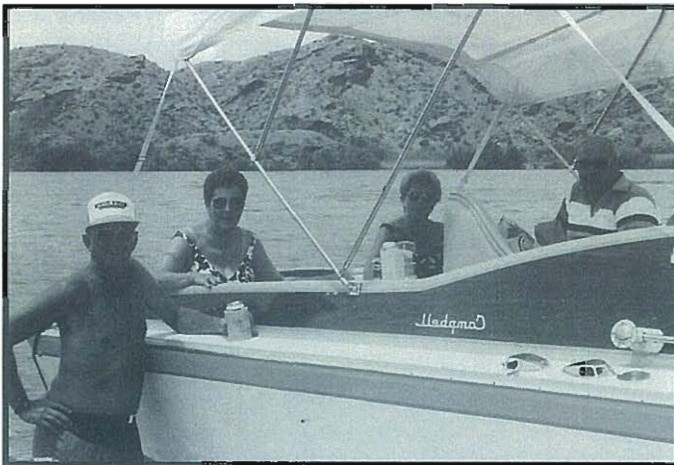

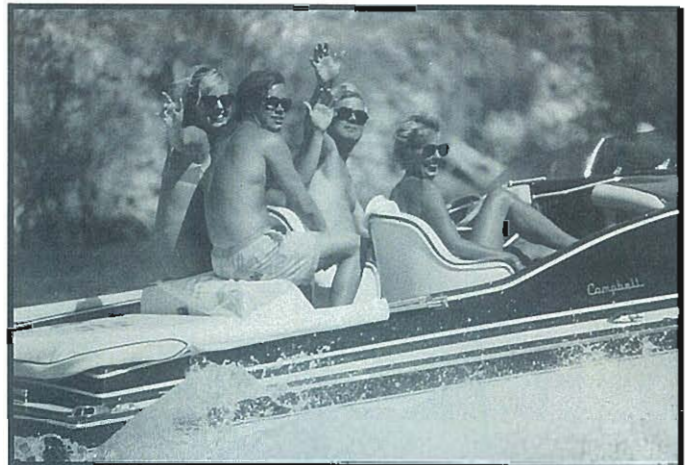
