All in all a lot of fun - think we'll do it again, September 9, 10, 11, 1994!



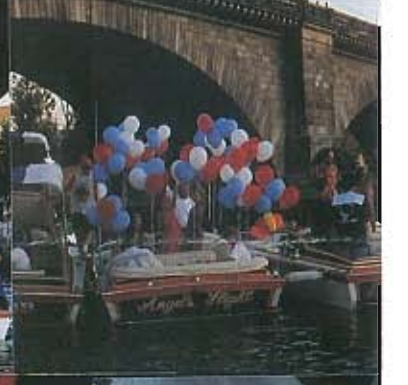
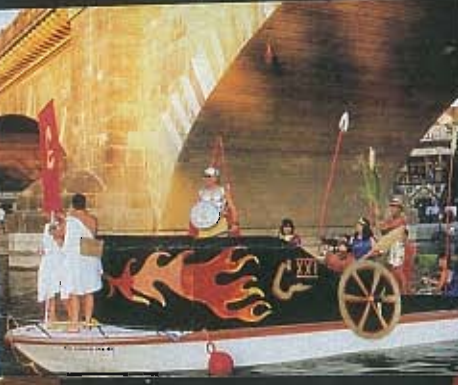
